Duties and Responsibilities

- Responsible for the set-up, adjustment and repair of looms using knowledge of loom function, weaving, diagrams and manuals.
- Accurately enter or remove parts from the inventory system
- Inspection of looms and/or woven cloth to determine adjustments or repairs needed as using the production control systems to see which looms need fixing and repairs
- Repair or replace defective parts and adjust the tension and timing of parts using hand tools
- Change set up of the loom to weave different patterns and fabrics
- Change the roll covering or replace rollers on a loom, periodic maintenance and lubrication to assigned looms
- Daily department cleaning and organizing
- Effectively communicating with supervisors and other teams on all shifts
- Completion of all required paperwork

- Two (2) years' experience with projectile looms, preferably Sulzer P7200
- Three (4) years' experience working in the textile industry of manufacturing
